

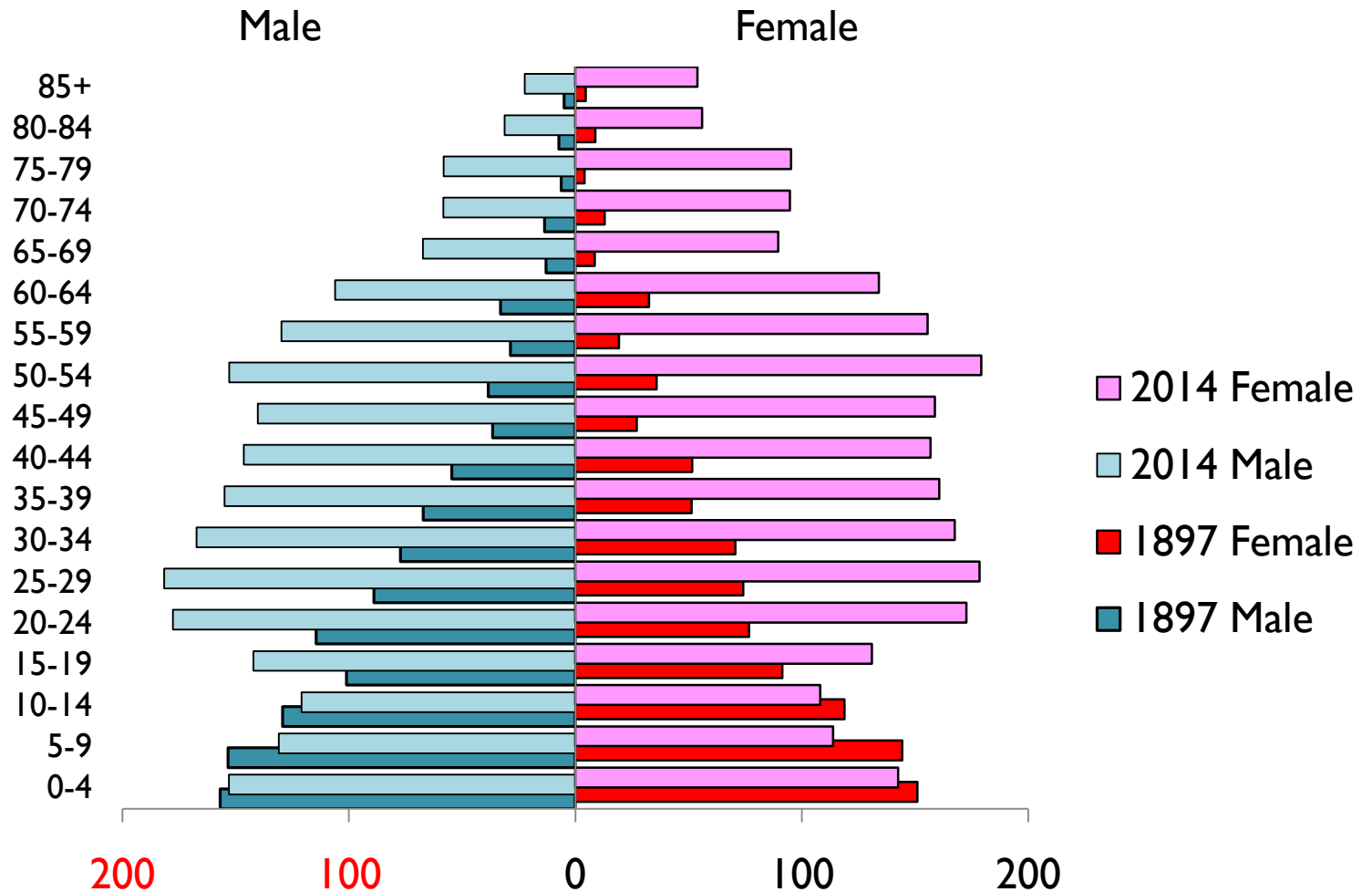

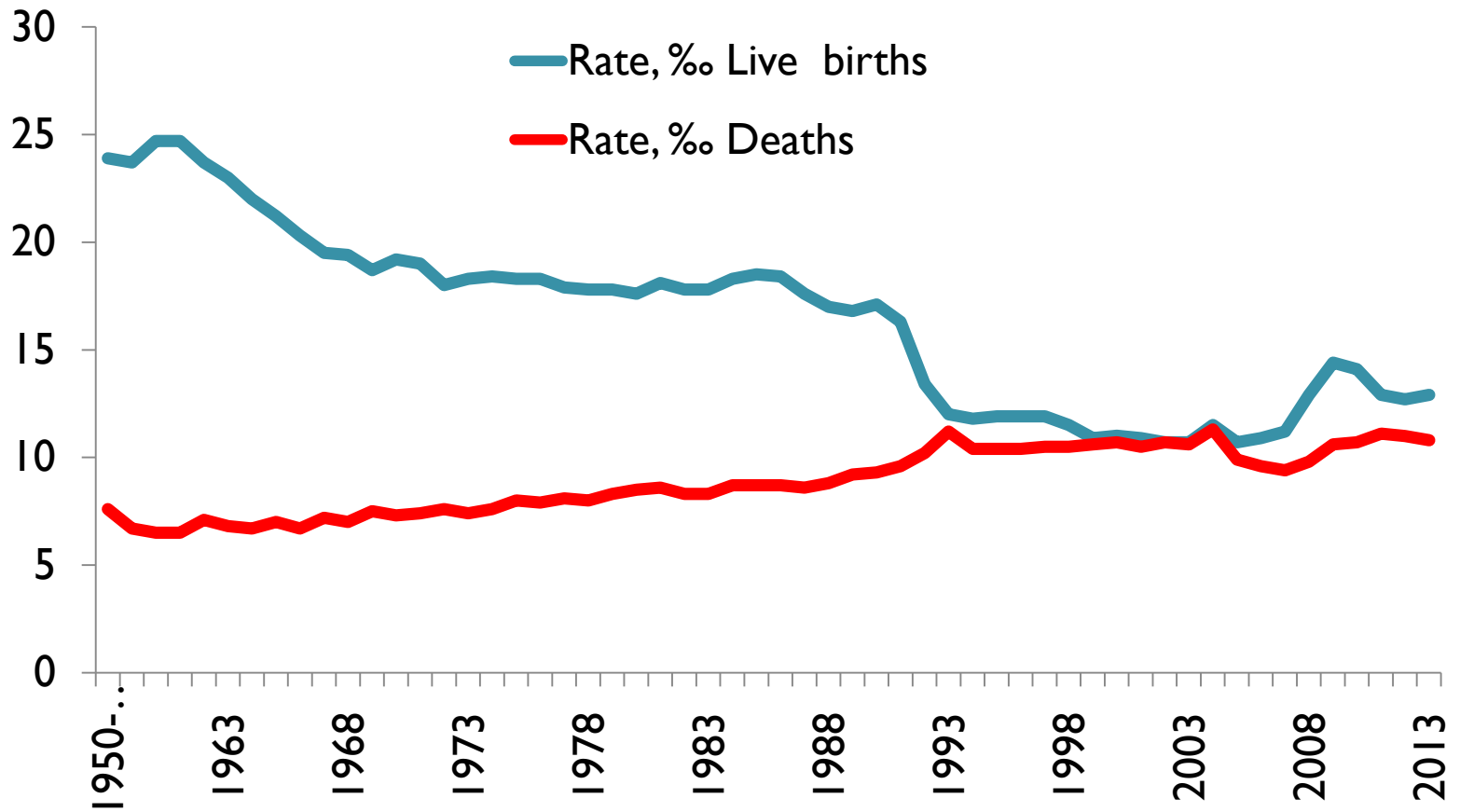

Live Births & Deaths (‰)

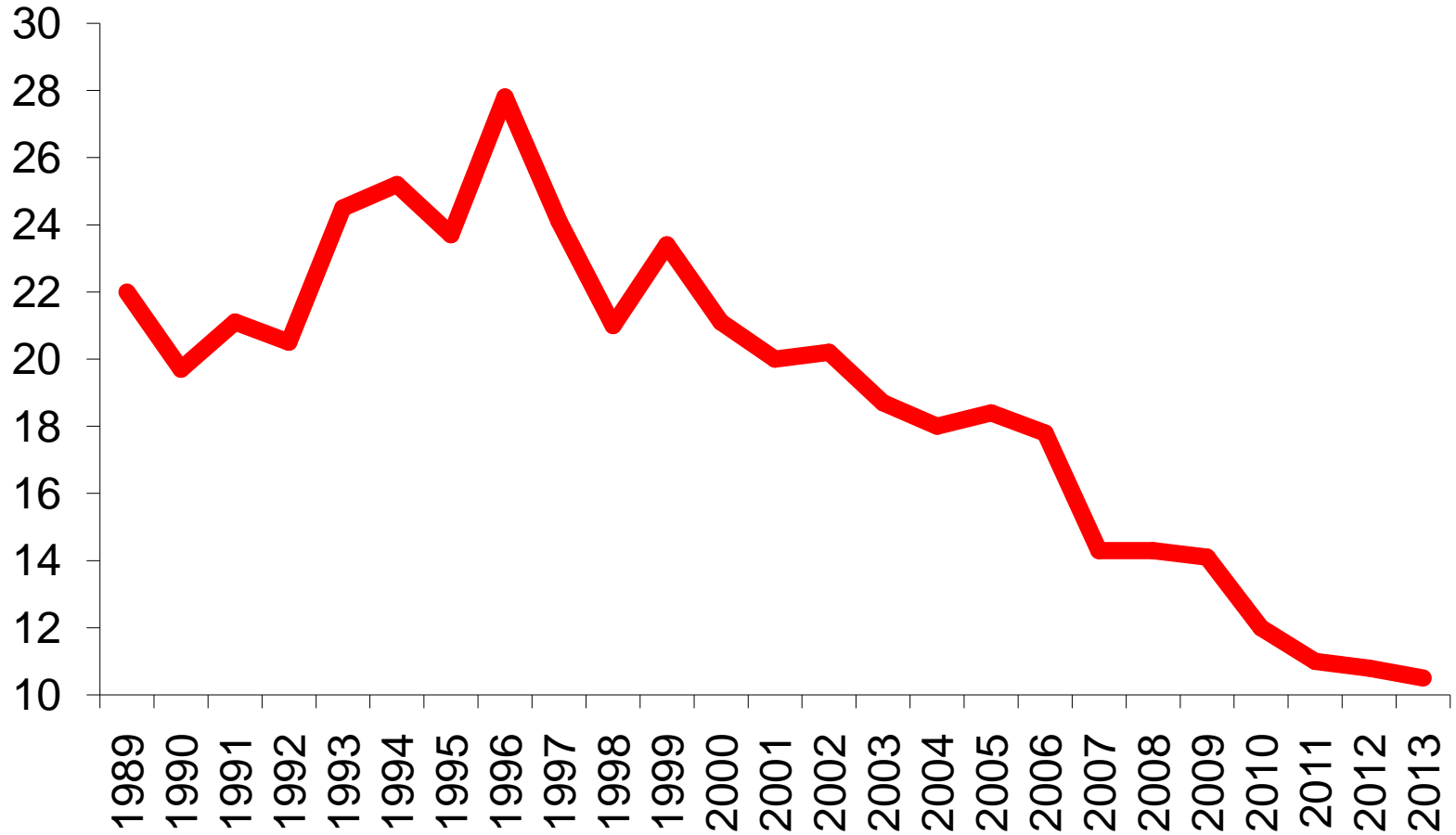

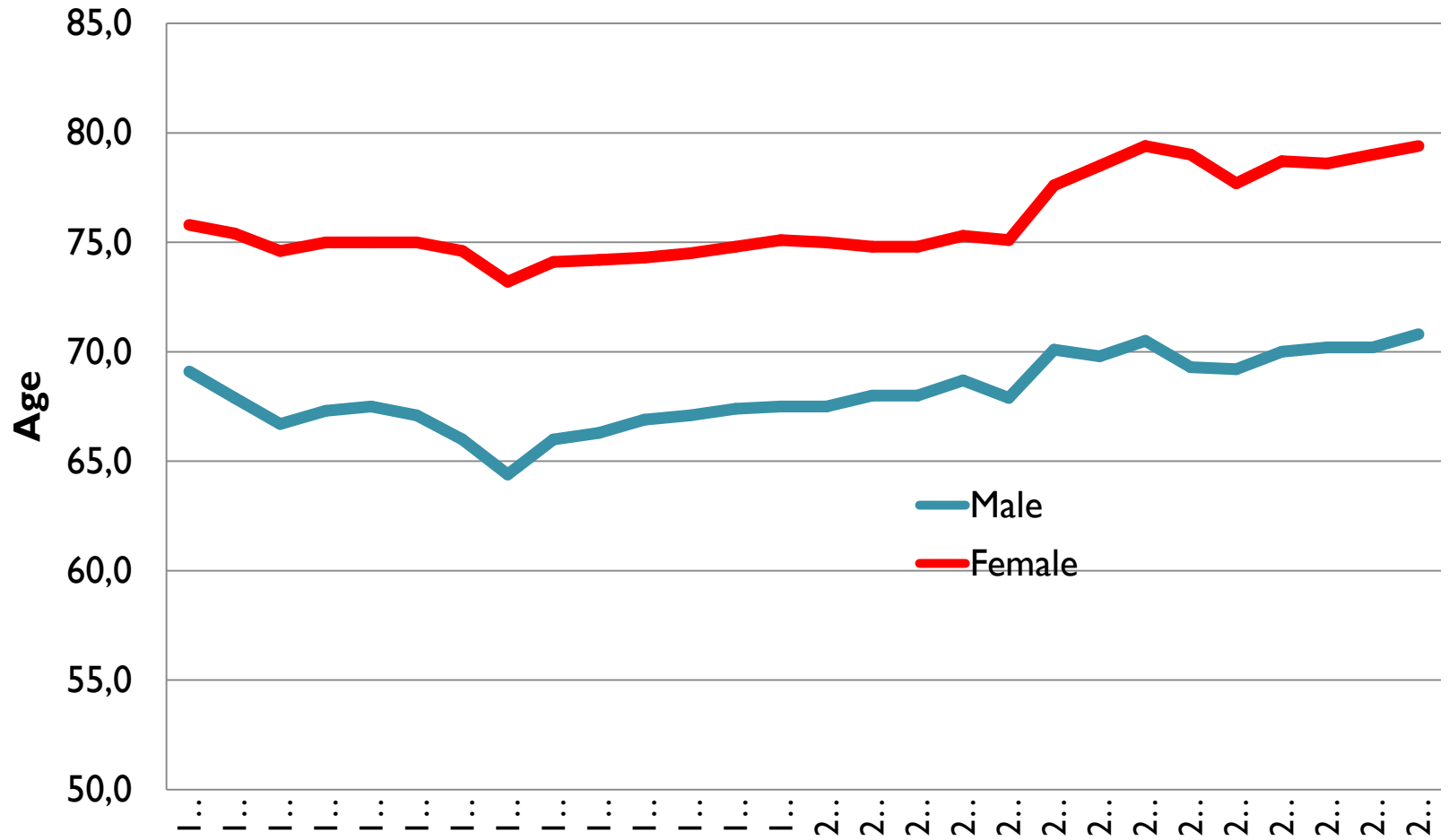
- Georgia

- Deaths – 10.8 (GeoStat), 13.4 Evaluations)
- Infant mortality – 11.1 (GeoStat), 17.4 Evaluations)

- Live Births - 11
- Deaths – 11
- Infant mortality - 5

Infant Mortality Rates

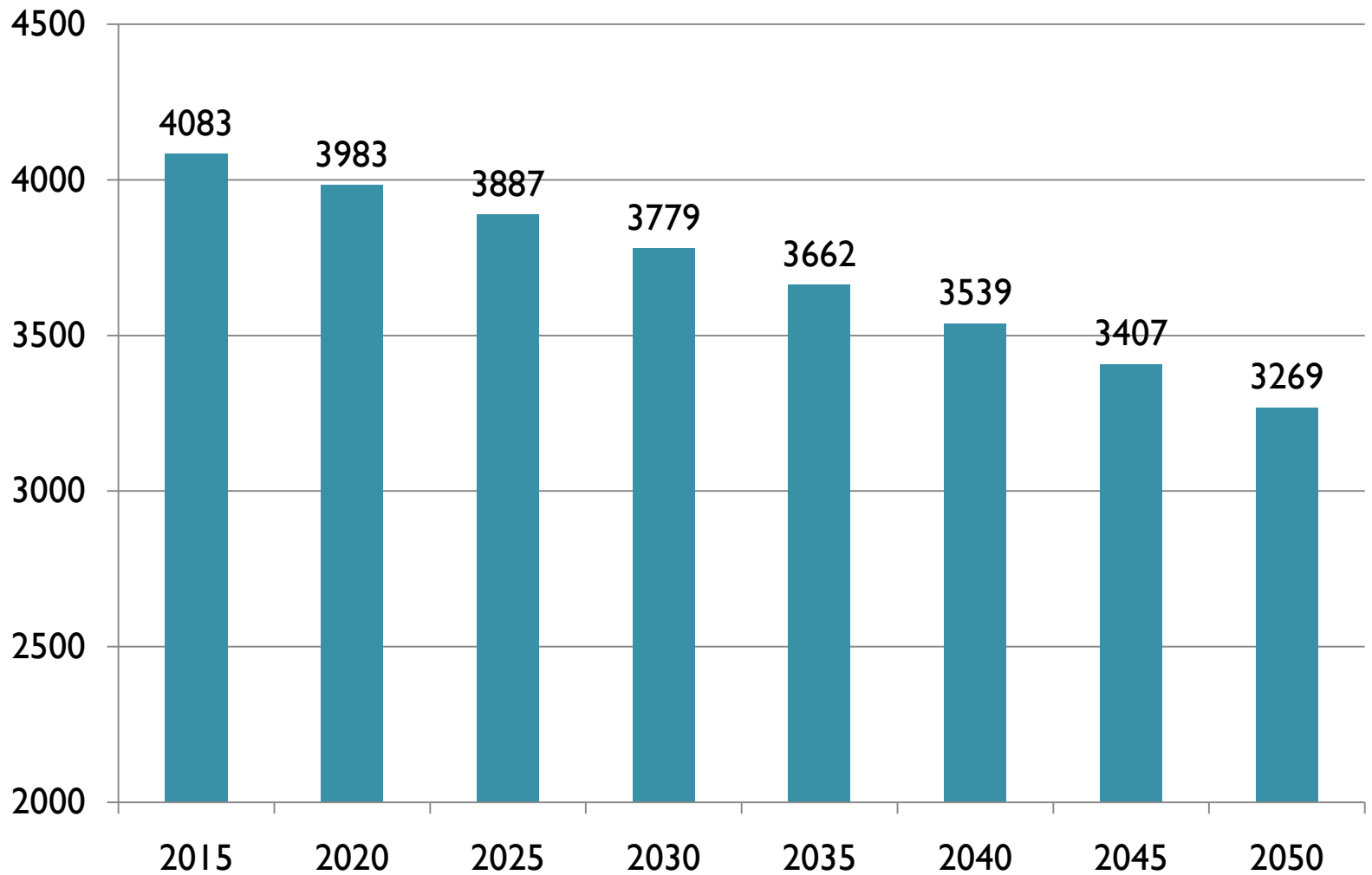


Life Expectancy

Population Prospects by 2050

- -15 declines to 15%
- 65+ exceeds 24%
- Natural Increase declines by 18 000 per year
- Net Migration reaches -10 000 per year
- Life Expectancy – 75.3 for men, 81.1 for women
- Infant Mortality -12 (per 1000 Live births)
